#### **August to October**

# FORMATION OF NEW CORE COMMITTEES AND ACHIEVEMENTS

- The coordinator can appoint local facilitators in states to make communication effective and to stay updated on progress made by the states.

# HALAQAAT-E-DUROOD APPLICATION AND MINHAJ CONNECT UPDATES

- The Halaqaat-e-Durood application, along with Minhaj Connect, continues to evolve, with new features introduced to enhance user experience.
- These platforms are informative as well as participative.
   Halaqaat-e-Durood application shows the list containing
   states with the highest halqate durood centres and total
   count of durood shareef recited, followed by the second
   & third highest, and so on.
- Minhaj Connect platform is a stop solution for every kind of donation which helps us to ease remote participation and engagement, keeping members connected and informed about ongoing events and initiatives.



#### **MEMBERSHIP DRIVE INITIATIVE**

- A Membership Drive Coordinator, now part of the Steering Council, has been appointed to lead an extensive membership campaign. With a goal to increase Minhaj ul Quran International India's reach and engage the community, the coordinator has selected representatives in various states to promote and oversee membership activities.
- Regular training and resources are provided to streamline member conversion and ensure the success of this focused project.
- States are encouraged to frequently take active part in the membership drive.

#### **ENHANCING SOCIAL MEDIA PRESENCE**

Efforts to expand Minhaj ul Quran International India's digital presence include launching the ILHAM podcast channel, which features content aimed at spreading the books' content of Huzoor Sheikh-ul-Islam, Dr. Hasan Mohiuddin Qadri, and Dr. Hussain Mohiuddin Qadri, inline with the current trend of social media engagement. For this purpose, a dedicated team has been formed to launch the Podcast and other Social Media activities to capture as many eyes as possible.



 In addition, a Wikipedia page for Minhaj-ul-Quran International India has been established, providing a reliable source of information on organizational structure, current leadership, and state-level constituents. This page serves as a single information resource, updated regularly by state representatives.




#### **BOOKS DISTRIBUTION DRIVE**

- This project focuses on sharing Minhaj ul Quran's publications with scholars and intellectuals across various faiths, with a particular emphasis on peace, Sufism, and interfaith dialogue.
- Young members, particularly those interested in digital media, are involved in creating engaging content for social media to reach a broader audience and inspire new members to join. This department works closely with the department discussed in the preceding point.

#### MINHAJ STUDENT LEAGUE

- Minhaj ul Quran International India has recently placed the first constituent brick of Minhaj Student League in Aligarh Muslim University.
- This league has its first body of young enthusiastic minds which belongs to diverse state but are pursuing their education in Aligarh Muslim University.
- This league aims to connect collegegoing learners by inculcating in them the mission of the organisation. This league also focuses on joining hands with the professors and eminent



figures of universities. For this purpose, initial steps are to offer them the literature by Huzoor Sheikh ul Islam with frequent meetings to discuss the literature offered.

#### **WOMEN'S LEAGUE INITIATIVES**

- Women's Leagues in Maharashtra, Karnataka, Telangana, and Kutch actively organize programs throughout the year, such as *Milad un Nabi* gatherings and *Halagaat-e-Durood*.
- Telangana's Women's League organised a 10day Milad event with over 100 women participating, which gives a strong sense of unity and spiritual growth..
- The Women's league's events in various states serve to connect women from diverse backgrounds, Which offers both religious as well as social & mental support to them.



# MLRC (ISLAM FOR KIDS) PROGRAM EXPANSION

- The MLRC (Islam for Kids) education model is at the verge of expanding beyond Delhi because of new locations actively showing their commitment and participation.
- Leveraging Social media, particularly on Instagram, has significantly increased MLRC's visibility, leading to a growth of over 1,500 new followers and requests from other states for similar programs in their states too.
- Additionally, the MLRC team is developing online courses to make their programs accessible nationwide, bridging geographic barriers.
- The Islam for Kids book series is now available on Amazon and Flipkart, ensuring that parents and educators across the country can easily access these resources.







# ISLAM FOR KIDS PROFESSIONAL VISITS TO VARIOUS SCHOOLS

This professional visit of Islam for Kids delegates was organised to have a communication session with the schools situated in Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The aim of this visit is to spread awareness about the engaging syllabus of Islam for Kids which is tailored to suit to need of the particular age group of children. Our Madhya Pradesh State Coordinator and



other equally capable people has facilitated the visit. 10 Schools were visited and communicated for having Islam for Kids as their Syllabus for the Islamic studies subject. The schools showed their interest to adapt with Islam for Kids as their curriculum. Islam for Kids team is in constant touch with them for further communication or to take order directly.

- The Sewing Machine Project, aimed at economic empowerment of women, has launched recently in Kashmir. This project is already running in Mysore (Karnataka) and successfully concluded in Calcutta, and Madhya Pradesh.
- This project enables underprivileged individuals, especially women, to earn a sustainable livelihood after the programme.
- We are constantly striving to achieve 100% self sustaining viable scheme of this project.

# November 2024 to January 2025 PROJECT OXYGEN FOR INDIA SRINAGAR INITIATIVE

 Project Oxygen for India has taken root in Srinagar, with eight oxygen concentrators delivered to the team for deployment in high-need areas.



• This project aims to support old age individuals and those with respiratory issues during winter, with concentrators allocated to serve 8-10 districts in a routine basis.

# WATER HAND PUMP INSTALLATION IN BIHAR

- Recently, A water hand pump has been installed in Bihar to serve underprivileged communities in the district of Navada, Bihar.
- Two additional installations have been planned.
   Suitable locations are being identified, after which the digging process will commence to expand access to clean water in the region.




#### **KERALA FLOOD RELIEF APPEAL**

 In response to the recent floods in Kerala, MIWF initiated a fundraising campaign on Ketto and social media, raising a workable funds to support relief efforts. These funds will soon be allocated to assist affected individuals and communities.



#### WINTER BLANKET DISTRIBUTION CAMPAIGN

- MIWF's winter relief campaign has launched. It's now at stage 01, which is fundraising. For raising funds, we often utilised our members as well as Social Media platforms, including Ketto fundraiser.
- Every winter MIWF tries to make arrangements for providing basic & fundamental needs of destitute people who don't have shelter to stay in or are suffering from other calamities so they can not purchase one. MIWF stands with them by giving them blankets so they can survive the chilling winds of winter.
- This project is designed to provide blankets to the destitute in the chilly winters, with the aim of distributing supplies once sufficient funds are raised. This initiative seeks to protect vulnerable people from the harsh winter conditions.



#### **MICRO FINANCING: AN OPPORTUNITY OF DIGNITY**



Minhaj Interfaith & Welfare Foundation (MIWF) keeps searching for like-minded organisations that actually choose to work for the upliftment of the underprivileged people. Recently, MIWF collaborated with such



captured and directed towards the concern of the ummah with their solutions as provided by Minhaj ul Quran.


#### **MINHAJ EDUCATION & TRAINING INDIA**



In the last ten days (ashra), a special arrangement for Quran recitation sessions was organized for a total of 10 days.






The event concluded with prayers for peace and blessings, leaving attendees inspired and content.
